Have you ever thought about how many children are affected by bullying every day?

Here are some facts you should know:

Bullying facts: Did you know?

It is hard to stand up to a bully, because you may think the bully is stronger or braver than you are. But the truth is, usually the bully is not very confident inside.

Every 7 minutes, someone is bullied on a school playground.

Kids who see bullying may keep quiet because they are afraid they will be bullied, too.

According to a survey of 1,500 students, half said they have seen someone else being bullied.

Remember: bullying is NEVER okay!

Kids think that telling an adult about a bully is "tattling." It is not. It is the right thing to tell an adult.

Bullying can happen in any grade – even kindergarten.

Kids who bully others think it will help them be "cool" or fit in – it doesn't.

Kids who are bullied are twice as likely to feel afraid to go to school.

WHAT BULLYING IS NOT

Q: Are there different kinds of bullying?

A: Yes, there are four kinds:

1. **PHYSICAL** – hitting, kicking, biting, pushing; also taking someone's stuff
2. **VERBAL** – name-calling, teasing, making fun of a person
3. **EMOTIONAL** – telling lies about someone; spreading rumors; excluding someone
4. **CYBERBULLYING** is a type of "emotional" bullying. Cyberbullying happens online when someone posts something mean or embarrassing about another person on Facebook, for example; or when someone spreads lies through email or text messages.

Q: Is it bullying if someone is mean ONCE?

A: No. Bullying is when one person **repeatedly** picks on another person. Bullying may happen every day or every week, for example.

Q: Is it bullying if someone just wants to be alone or chooses another best friend?

A: No. Bullying is **intentionally** being mean or harmful.

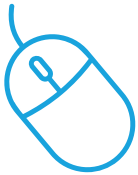

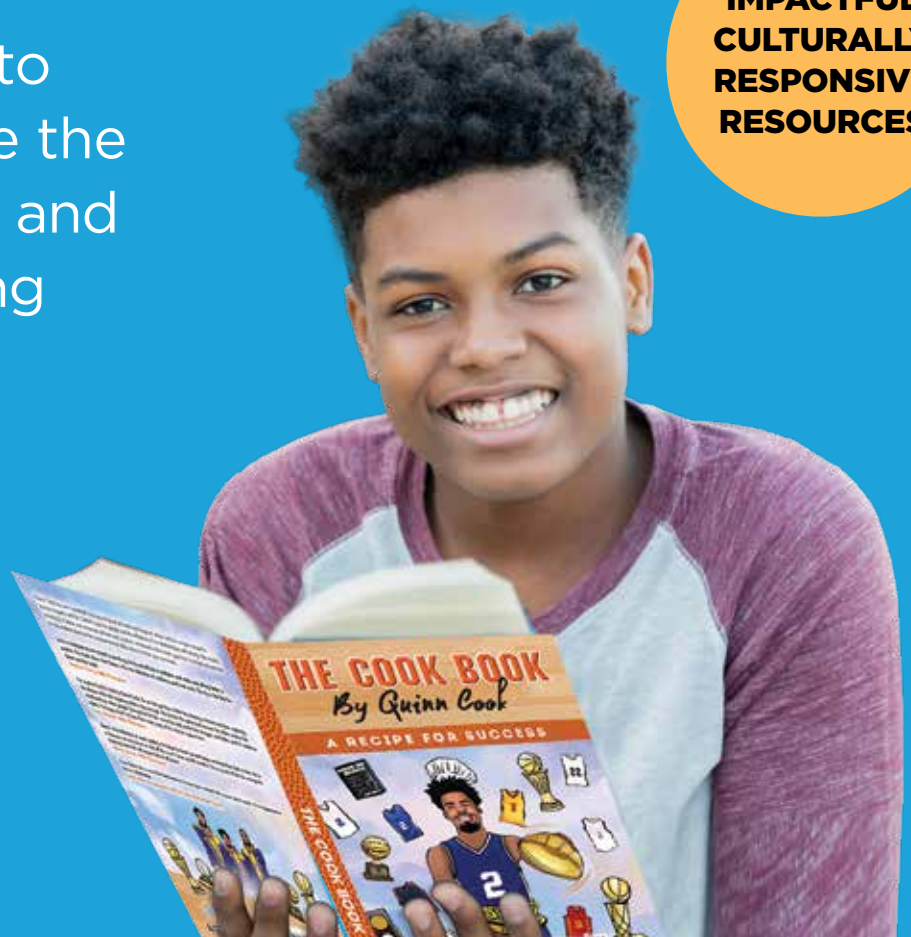
